For each course it is essential to define a number of topics, and accept them on the Study Group. 3. Equal distribution of topics for the Final Paper among courses. 4. Multidisciplinarity of topics. 5. In the process of writing the Final Paper, a student can consult a mentor and other professors who work in the same field. 6. The Final Paper cannot be submitted nor defended before it is approved by the mentor and consulted professors. 7. Consulted professors are part of a committee for Final Paper Defense. 8. The head of the study program is the member of the committee. 9. The defense is scheduled within 30 days after the paper submission and announced on the notice board.
